Professor, Center for Molecular Medicine and Genetics, Pediatrics and Pathology
Wayne State University School of Medicine

Dr. Feldman is a Professor in the Departments of Pediatrics, Pathology and the Center for Molecular Medicine and Genetics at Wayne State University School of Medicine (WSU-SOM), where he is the Director of Clinical Genetic Services. He is Medical Director of the Division of Laboratory Genetics and Molecular Pathology at the Detroit Medical Center University Laboratories. He is Board-Certified in Clinical Genetics and Clinical Molecular/Biochemical Genetics. He is the Director of the Medical Genetics Residency and Fellowship Programs and is the Director of the Newborn Screening Management Program at Children’s Hospital of Michigan.

Dr. Feldman is the Director of the State of Michigan’s Newborn Screening Management Program at Children’s Hospital of Michigan and is a member of the State of Michigan’s Newborn Screening Subcommittee and the Metabolic Quality Improvement Committee.

He is the immediate Past President of the American College of Medical Genetics and Genomics. He is a past President of the Association of Professors of Human and Medical Genetics. He was a member and Chair of

the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education Residency Review Committee for Medical Genetics and a member and Vice-Chair of the College of American Pathologist’s Biochemical and Molecular Genetics Subcommittee.

Dr. Feldman has published over 85 peer-reviewed articles and 6 book chapters. His research interests include the molecular diagnosis of genetic disorders, medical genetics residency training and education and newborn screening.
